

USA Swimming Steps – New Parent Member

First – you must create a parent account/login. This is NOT a membership, rather a “SWIMS” account where parents can manage/view their child(ren)’s info/registration/times

Parent SWIMS account steps:

- 1) Go to: <https://hub.usaswimming.org/landing>
- 2) Click “Login/Register” in upper right corner
- 3) Click “Create a Login” box
- 4) Select “No” for Existing Account
- 5) Select “Yes” for Over 16 (for parent of minor)
- 6) Fill out User Info to create login/account (USE SAME EMAIL FOR CLUB REGISTRATION)
- 7) Fill in Member ID only if linking to another swimmer or parent account
- 8) Verify your email by retrieving the code from your email, enter it and click Submit
- 9) Verify your contact info is correct
- 10) Review and click Yes for all legal acknowledgements, type signature, and Submit

Second – Use the USA Swimming registration link provided to you by Swim 5150 to register your child(ren) with USAS and get their Member ID #

The “**Premium**” membership is the most common registration. It costs \$78/year. It is available to any age child and includes unlimited meets.

The “**Flex**” membership is \$28/year and is available to swimmers age 12 and under. It includes 2 meets per year. (no state champ meet)

The “**Individual Season Athlete**” membership lasts 150 days. It is available to any age child and would be great for a swimmer who only swims winter OR summer season. It includes unlimited meets in the time period and costs \$48.

The “**Outreach**” membership is available only to scholarship swimmers who have been approved through 5150’s application process. The link for this registration is different and would be sent separately by 5150 if applicable.

Swimmer Registration steps:

- 1) Follow this link:

- 2) Click the button for “REGISTER MEMBER”
- 3) Click “I AM REGISTERING MY CHILD”
- 4) Fill out the “About Member” fields with your child’s information. Click “Continue”
- 5) Fill out the “Member Contact” fields with parent information. Click “Continue”
- 6) Under “Membership” you will chose your membership type. Then Click “Continue”
- 7) Under “Ethnicity” make a selection. Then Click “Continue”
- 8) Under “Competition Category” make a selection. Then Click “Continue”
- 9) Review and click Yes for all legal acknowledgements, type signature, and Submit
- 10) Check out and pay for your child’s membership

FAQ: why does my child need a USA Swimming ID?

Wyoming Swimming (our statewide governing body) is a USAS member institution. All meets in Wyoming are sanctioned through Wyoming Swimming, and Wyoming Swimming requires all clubs to be USAS institutions. The local clubs pay a fee to USAS, and in return USAS provides vital insurance coverage and promotes a safe, abuse-free environment for athletes and coaches through required training and background checks. In order to maintain our insurance, USA Swimming requires all swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers to be registered and maintain certification requirements.
